In learning

A (sub-total) count of those Year 11 leavers who have chosen a post-16 activity which involves structured learning, either

- on a full-time course of further education in a sixth form or at a college
- in an Apprenticeship (***employed Status***) OR other employment with a structured training programme which leads to a qualification or local recognition of Skills
- in work-based learning (***non-employed status***)

Continued full-time education

A count of those Year 11 leavers who have chosen to continue in education on a full-time course (***16 hours or more***) in all types of post-16 education institution.

Structured learning in the workplace

A count of those Year 11 leavers who have chosen an activity which involves structured training, either:

- Apprenticeship or Advanced Apprenticeship programmes
- other supported training programmes
- jobs with planned off-the-job training funded by the employer
- jobs with locally recognised good quality training
- some structured personal development/volunteering programmes or similar locally-funded projects (eg Stoke Challenge)

Jobs with no structured training

A count of those Year 11 leavers who have taken up a job which does not offer training to NVQ/equivalent or locally recognised good quality training (beyond induction or basic health & safety training). The vast majority of temporary jobs fall into this category

Not settled (mainly NEET)

All those Year 11 leavers who are not yet settled in full-time education, employment or training. They may be:

- NEET - active in the labour market i.e. unemployed (***Small numbers of young people will be doing a positive part-time activity such as part-time learning or employment or volunteering***)
- NEET - inactive in the labour market (***e.g. caring, pregnancy, illness***) unavailable to the labour market (***e.g. custody, religious belief, refugee or asylum seeking***).

No response or moved away

A count of those Year 11 leavers:

- for whom no reliable information can be gained as to their activity
- who have moved and no activity status is known,

(A very small number of young people may refuse to take part in the survey.)

Education Other Than School Provision

This is amalgamated data on the activities taken up by leavers for whom part or whole of their final year of compulsory education was provided by means other than mainstream or special schools. Such provision includes pupil referral units, colleges, training providers, young offender's institutions, home tutored and those formally educated at home.
